



## WHAT IS STIGMA?

Sigma is when negative attitudes and beliefs are guided towards individuals who are viewed as different from others and influenced by environmental factors, such as society and culture (Montenegro et al., 2022). This can be perceived as being different from others and reducing a person's status.

Stigma has been found to be an influential factor within the Latinx community, specifically those with children with autism spectrum disorder, also referred to as ASD (Cohen & Miguel, 2018).

This has hindered children with ASD by the following:

- Preventing families from seeking answers and resources
- Delaying diagnosis



## IMPACT OF STIGMA

It was recognized that Latinx mothers of children with ASD experienced the following internalized emotions:

- Guilt
- Remorse
- Shame
- Isolation
- Influenced stress
- Frustration
